
Dear Mr. Ugljanin,

We were recently informed that Special Rapporteur for Human Rights (Mr. Tadeusz Mazowiecki, former Polish Prime Minister) is undertaking a 6-day mission to the territory of the former Yugoslavia during the period 21 - 26 August. The Special Rapporteur and approximately seven members of his party are scheduled to be in Belgrade on Tuesday, 25 August. UNPROFOR has been requested to provide assistance to Mr. Mazowiecki and his party.

UNPROFOR HQ has asked me to convey to you that the Special Rapporteur would very much appreciate the opportunity to meet with a representative of your organization on his visit to Belgrade. Although we realize his visit falls on the day prior to the first day of the London Conference, may we inquire if you, or in your absence another representative of your organization, would be able to meet with the Special Rapporteur and his party on 25 August at the Hyatt hotel board room, at 07.00 p.m.

The purpose of the Special Rapporteur's visit to the area is to investigate first-hand the human rights situation in the territory of the former Yugoslavia, and to visit "areas of interest" in order to prepare a report which is to be presented to the Secretary-General by 28 August. The Secretary-General has been requested to present the report to the Security Council.
